The first two volumes were the work of Cook, the third by Captain James King. A renewed Resolution, under Cook, finally got off on the late evening of July 12, 1776—almost exactly four years after leaving on the previous successful voyage—a coincidence that some viewed as a favorable omen.

### **James Cook: Third Voyage - Princeton University**

Cook's journal of the third voyage was completed by one of his officers, James King. Minor indictments against Cook's character and unfounded charges that he was incompetent in dealing with natives have failed to diminish his standing as the greatest British explorer. He was the first navigator to apply scientific method to exploration.
